- * To revise the Regulation-650 & 657 :-
 - Regulation 650 is revised as under : R-650 :- In order to pass an examination, an examinee must have obtained:-
 - i) To pass the Examination a candidate must obtain 40% of Marks in each Theory Paper and Internal / Sessional taken together [including Sesstional i.e. 40 out of 100 Marks] however candidate must also have to obtain minimum 40% of Marks in Theory Paper [excluding Sessional i.e. 32 out of 80] separately and 45% of Marks in each practical paper and Internal / Sessional taken together [including Sesstional i.e. 45 out of 100 Marks] however candidate must also have to obtain minimum 45% of Marks in practical paper [excluding Sessional i.e. 36 out of 80] separately.
 - ii) Must have obtained at least 50% of the total marks assigned to that examination.
- * Regulation 657is revised as under :-

R-657 :- If the candidate remains absent for Internal/Sessional his performances should be treated as zero mark. There shall not be separate passing for Internal/Sessional.

* New Regulation 657(A):- There will be no result for Sem.I, III, V & VII only subject performance will be shown on marks sheet as per Engineering Course.

Gracing of Marks should be done as a whole for Semester-I and II, Semester-III & IV, Semester-V & VI and Semester-VII & VIII Examination taken together respectively. - 3 -
