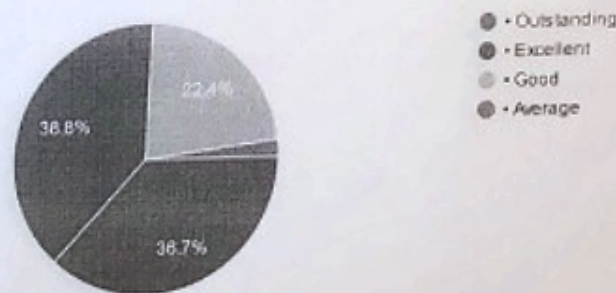
### 1.4.2 Structured Feedback received from the Alumni (Academic Year 2022-23)

1) The Course & Programme objectives & outcomes were clearly defined identified?  
49 responses



The majority of respondents (77.6%) highly praised the clarity and identification of course and program objectives, with 42.9% rating them as "Outstanding" and 34.7% as "Excellent." A moderate 20.4% found them "Good," while a minimal 2% deemed them "Average," indicating a generally positive perception but with some room for improvement.

2) Course Material were of appropriate length, high quality and up-to-date?

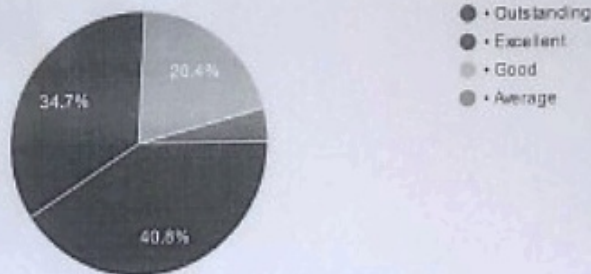


The assessment reveals strong satisfaction with course materials, as 75.5% of respondents rated them either "Outstanding" (36.7%) or "Excellent" (38.8%). An additional 22.4% found the materials to be "Good," implying overall positive feedback. Only a marginal 2.1% deemed the materials "Average," suggesting a generally high standard in terms of appropriateness, quality, and currency.

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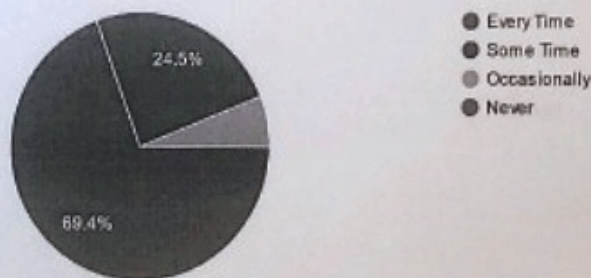
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3) The course provides focus on skill Development/ Employability / Entrepreneurship?




The evaluation indicates a positive perception of the course's emphasis on skill development, employability, and entrepreneurship, with a combined 75.5% of respondents rating it as either "Outstanding" (40.8%) or "Excellent" (34.7%). A moderate 20.4% found the focus "Good," highlighting an overall strong alignment with skill-building objectives. A marginal 4.1% rating the course as "Average" suggests that there is some room for enhancement in addressing these aspects for a small fraction of respondents.

49 responses

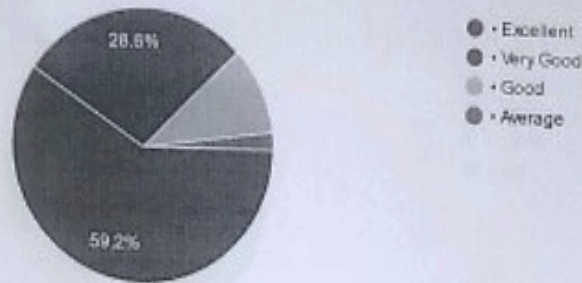


The analysis underscores a high level of consistency in the use of ICT tools for teaching, as a significant 69.4% of respondents reported that the teacher employed them every time. A notable 24.5% mentioned that ICT tools were used sometimes, indicating a considerable yet intermittent integration of these tools. A small fraction of 6.1% noted occasional use, suggesting room for more consistent implementation of ICT tools in teaching practices.

  
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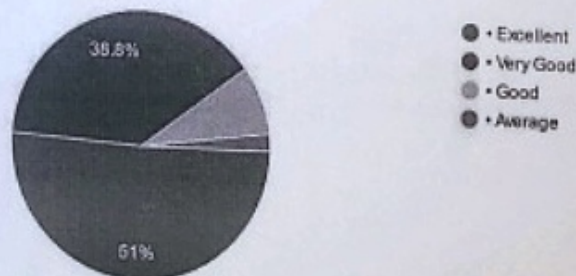


5) How do you grade the overall academic environment in the University?

49 responses

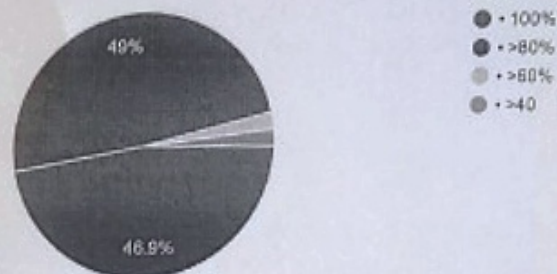


The evaluation of the University's extra-curricular environment indicates a positive outlook, with a substantial 89.8% of respondents rating it as either "Outstanding" (51%) or "Excellent" (38.8%). A smaller but still notable 8.2% found the extra-curricular environment to be "Good," reflecting a generally favorable perception. Only a marginal 2% considered it "Average," suggesting a high overall satisfaction with the University's extra-curricular offerings.

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7) To what extent course/programme learnt in the University benefitted you?

The analysis reveals a highly positive impact of the courses/programs at the University, as a substantial 96.9% of respondents reported significant benefits, with 46.9% attributing a full 100% benefit. An additional 49% indicated receiving benefits of over 80%, indicating a widespread satisfaction with the learning outcomes. Only a marginal 4% reported lower benefits, with 2% each for over 60% and over 40%, suggesting a minimal fraction experiencing less extensive advantages from the courses/programs.



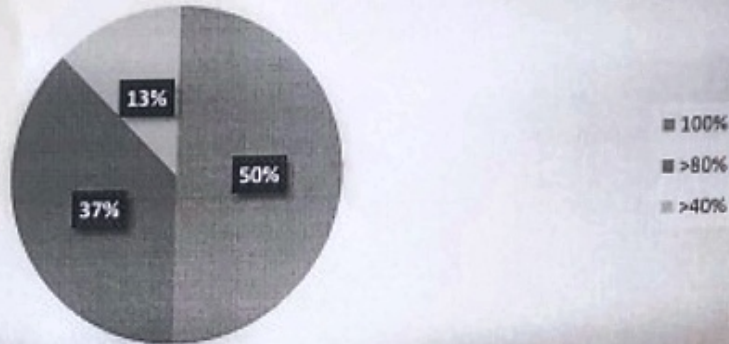


