
Minutes of the Departmental Committee held on 05,January 2024

- 6) Department plan to give more our extra curricular environment in the department with organizing more relate programs



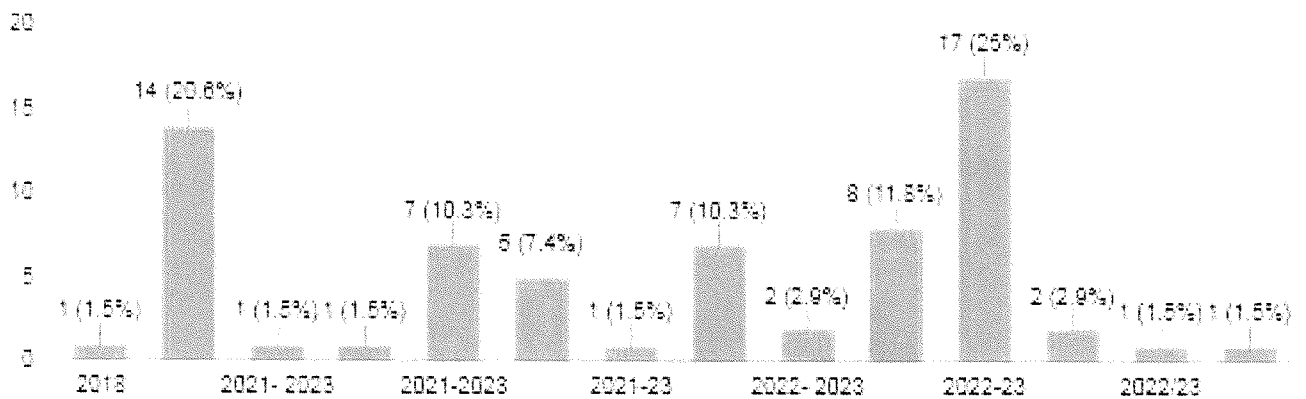

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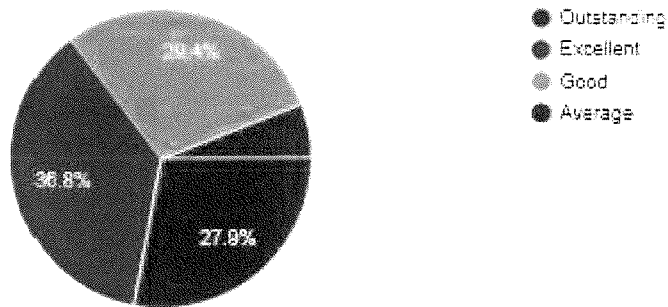

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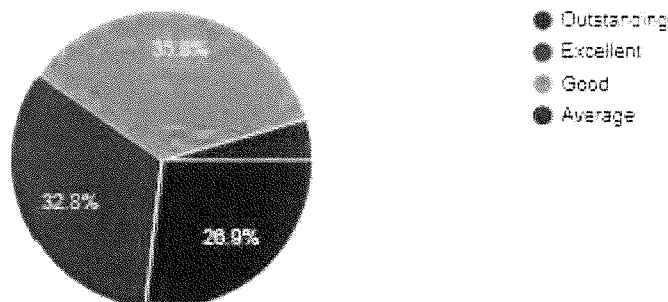

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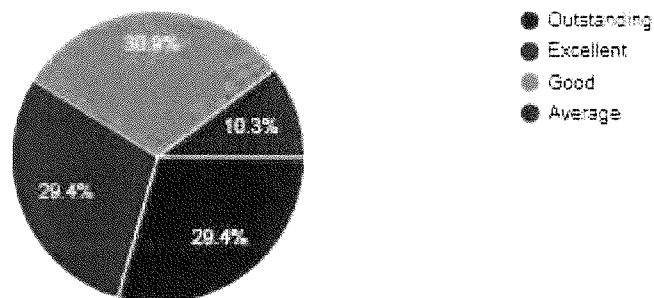

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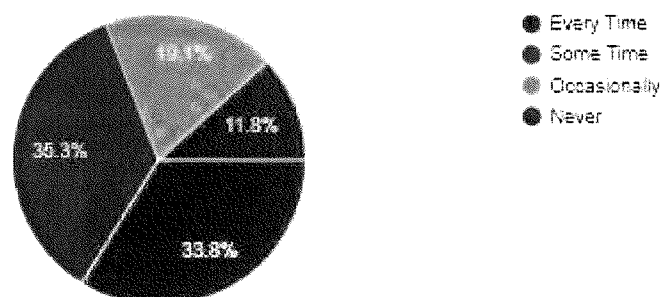

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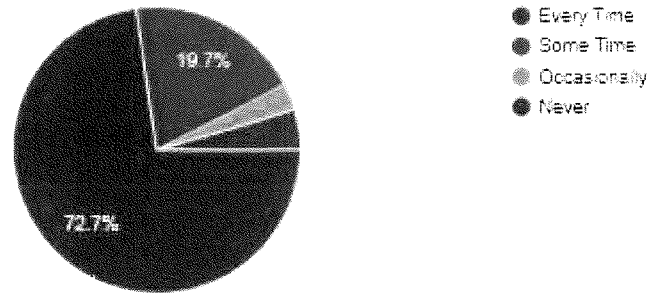

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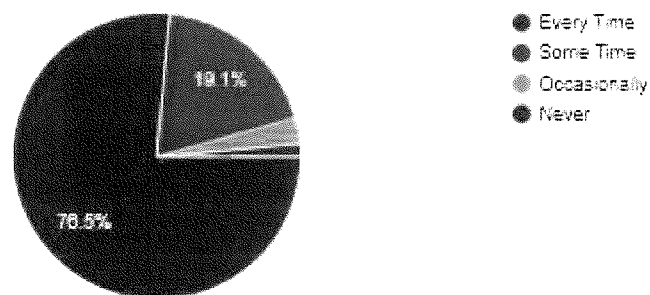

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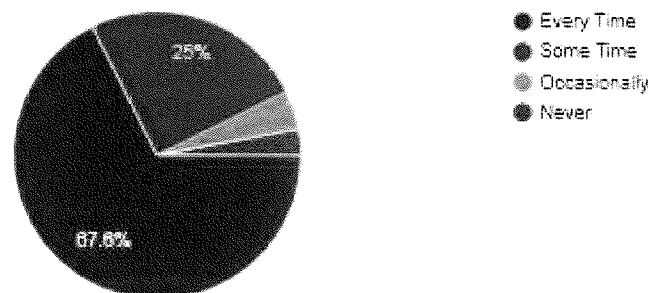

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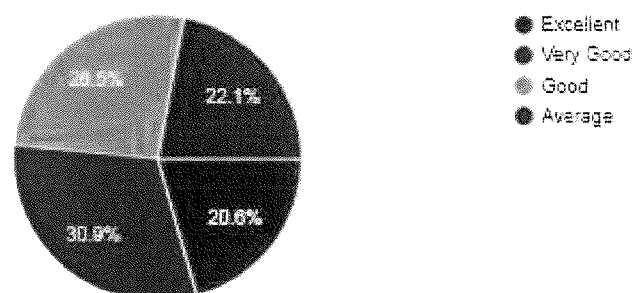

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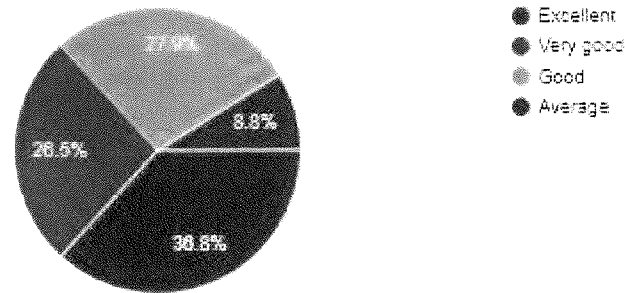

9) How would you rate the Library, Infrastructure and Laboratory facilities of the University ?

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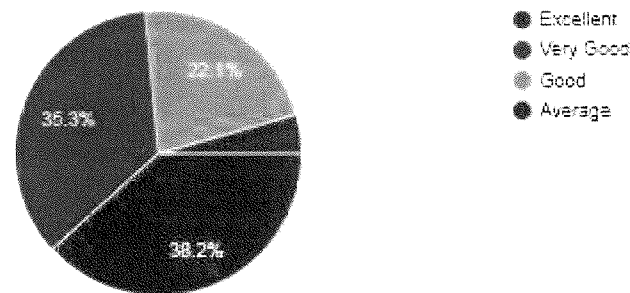

10) How would you rate the extra-curricular environment of the University ?

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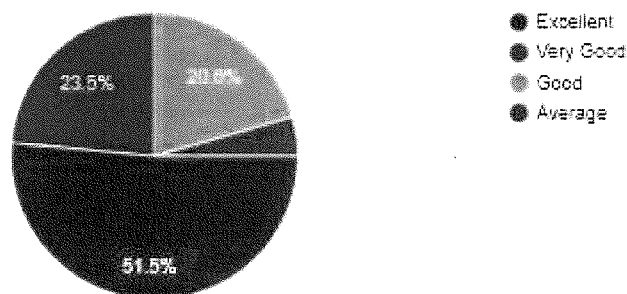
