





The analysis indicates a positive perception of the clarity and identification of course and program objectives and outcomes among the respondents, with a majority of 76% rating them as either "Outstanding" (52%) or "Excellent" (24%). A notable 19% found them to be "Good," indicating a generally favorable evaluation. A smaller yet noteworthy 5% considered the clarity and identification as "Average," suggesting room for improvement for a minority of participants.




The analysis reveals positive feedback regarding the clarity and identification of course and program objectives and outcomes among respondents, with a combined 71% rating them as either "Outstanding" (43%) or "Excellent" (28%). A substantial 24% found them to be "Good," indicating a generally favorable perception of the defined objectives and outcomes. A smaller,



yet notable, 5% considered the clarity and identification as "Average," suggesting there is room for improvement for a minority of participants.




The analysis indicates a positive outlook on the course's emphasis on skill development, employability, and entrepreneurship, with a combined 67% of respondents rating it as either "Outstanding" (48%) or "Excellent" (19%). A significant 24% found the focus "Good," suggesting a generally positive alignment with skill-building objectives. A smaller yet noteworthy 9% rated the course as "Average," indicating room for enhancement in addressing these aspects for a minority of participants.




The analysis reveals a predominant and consistent use of ICT tools for teaching, as a substantial 71% of respondents indicated that the teacher employs these tools every time. A small fraction

of 5% reported occasional use, suggesting infrequent integration of ICT tools. Another 24% mentioned that the tools are used sometimes, implying a moderate but intermittent utilization in teaching practices for this group of respondents.




The analysis of responses suggests an overwhelmingly positive perception of the overall academic environment in the University, with a combined 76% of respondents rating it as either "Excellent" (52%) or "Very Good" (24%). A moderate 19% found the academic environment to be "Good," indicating overall satisfaction. Only a marginal 5% considered it "Average," emphasizing the widespread positive sentiment towards the University's academic atmosphere among the participants.



The analysis of responses highlights a highly positive perception of the extra-curricular environment in the University, with a significant 86% of respondents rating it as either

"Excellent" (48%) or "Very Good" (38%). A moderate 9% found the extra-curricular environment to be "Good," reflecting positive sentiments. A minimal 5% considered it "Average," indicating a predominant satisfaction with the University's extra-curricular offerings among the participants.



The analysis demonstrates a highly positive impact of the courses/programs at the University, with a significant 90% of respondents reporting substantial benefits. Nearly half, 43%, indicated a full 100% benefit, while an additional 47% reported benefits exceeding 80%. A smaller yet noteworthy 10% mentioned benefits over 60% or 40%, emphasizing a widespread positive perception of the educational outcomes.
