

1.4.2 Structured Feedback received from the Alumni (Academic Year 2021-22)




The analysis suggests a positive perception of the clarity and identification of course and program objectives and outcomes among respondents, with a majority of 69% rating them as "Outstanding" (45%) or "Excellent" (24%). A notable 28% found them to be "Good," indicating a generally favorable evaluation. Only a minimal 3% considered the clarity and identification as "Average," suggesting a strong alignment between stated objectives and perceived outcomes for the majority of participants.




The analysis of responses indicates overall positive feedback regarding the course materials, with a combined 66% of respondents rating them as either "Outstanding" (38%) or "Excellent" (28%). A significant 31% found the materials to be "Good," suggesting a generally satisfactory level of appropriateness, quality, and currency. Only a minimal 3% considered the course materials as "Average," indicating that the majority of participants perceived them positively next

Head ht of Geography




The analysis of responses reflects a positive outlook on the course's emphasis on skill development, employability, and entrepreneurship, with a combined 67% of respondents rating it as either "Outstanding" (46%) or "Excellent" (21%). A significant 29% found the focus to be "Good," suggesting a generally positive alignment with skill-building objectives. Only a marginal 4% rated the course as "Average," indicating that a small fraction of respondents perceived room for improvement in these aspects.



The analysis reveals a consistent and prevalent use of ICT tools for teaching, as a substantial 69% of respondents indicated that the teacher employs these tools every time. A notable 21% reported occasional use, suggesting a moderate but intermittent integration of ICT tools. A smaller yet appreciable 10% mentioned that the tools are used occasionally, implying some room for more consistent implementation in teaching practices for this segment of respondents.



The evaluation of the overall academic environment in the University suggests a highly positive sentiment, with a majority of 80% of respondents rating it as either "Excellent" (52%) or "Very Good" (28%). A moderate 17% found the academic environment to be "Good," indicating a generally favorable perception. Only a marginal 3% considered it "Average," suggesting a widespread satisfaction with the University's academic atmosphere among the respondents.



The analysis of responses indicates a highly positive perception of the extra-curricular environment in the University, with a significant 86% of respondents rating it as either "Excellent" (48%) or "Very Good" (38%). A moderate 10% found the extra-curricular environment to be "Good," reflecting overall positive sentiments. A minimal 4% considered it "Average," suggesting a predominant satisfaction with the University's extra-curricular offerings among the participan



The analysis underscores a highly positive impact of the courses/programs offered by the University, with a substantial 93% of respondents reporting significant benefits. Nearly half, 45%, indicated a full 100% benefit, while an additional 48% reported benefits exceeding 80%. A smaller yet appreciable fraction, 7%, mentioned benefits over 60% or 40%, emphasizing a widespread positive perception of the educational outcomes.
