




#### 1.4.2 Structured Feedback received from the students (Academic Year 2018-19)








## 2) Course Material were appropriate in length, high quality and up-to-date?







## 5) The teacher was fair and unbiased in examination process?






# 8) Does the Institute provides adequate ICT facilities (Computer, LCD Projects, Internet, Wi-Fi etc.) within campus?






