
Sanction of Science and Engineering Research Board (SERB) is hereby accorded to the above mentioned project at a total cost of Rs. 4525000/- (Rs. Forty Five Lakh Twenty Five Thousand Only) with break-up of Rs. 2500000/- under Capital (Non-recurring) head and Rs. 2025000/- under General (Recurring) head for a duration of 36 months. 
