## TasTAFE and Dr Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University, AURANGABAD (MS) INDIA

#### Purpose

The purpose of this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is to outline a written understanding to establish a spirit of collaboration in pursuing training and education opportunities upon agreed principles between **TasTAFE** and **BAMU** 

This is a non-binding MOU and is intended to clarify the nature and extent of the complementary activities that might be undertaken for the mutual benefit of the two parties. Unless otherwise negotiated each institution will be responsible for managing its own costs.

Commitments of specific institutional resources, personnel, space, facilities, or any other academic, practicum, or intellectual activities may be contemplated hereunder but are beyond the scope of this MOU.

To the extent that the implementation of any proposed activity requires a commitment of resources, personnel, creditbearing coursework, or intellectual property, a supplementary agreement must be negotiated and approved by the two parties before work on any of the projects can commence.

The activities contemplated by this MOU are based on a spirit of cooperation and reciprocity that is intended to be of mutual benefit to both parties.

#### Objective, Scope, and Major Activities

Both institutions aim to encourage the development of the following types of activities:

- Gain further mutual understanding of each organisation and promote an on-going relationship.
- Visits and informal exchanges of students, faculty and administrators in specific areas of skilled based education.
- Explore the possibilities for developing joint programs and collaboration.
- Explore ways to cooperate in skilled based education and training.
- To initiate co-operation for co-educational programs in Hospitality, Automotive Studies, Electro-technology, and other mutually agreed areas.
- Organise joint conference, webinars, symposia, or other meetings on subjects of mutual interest.
- Pursue avenues for graduate, skills based, and professional student exchange
- Pursue avenues for student exchange.

Other exchange and cooperation programs to which both parties agree.

#### Implementation of Activities

The two parties recognize that the implementation of any agreed upon activity will depend upon the interests and expertise of the individuals involved and the availability of financial resources, space and other resources. Accordingly, the implementation of any exchange or cooperative program based on this MOU shall be separately negotiated and determined between the two institutions. It is further expected that both parties will be compliant with all applicable State and federal laws and regulations and their own relevant policies.

#### Timeframe

This MOU will become effective when signed by both parties. The MOU will remain in effect for **five years** from the signature date, below, and may be renewed or amended by mutual agreement of the parties. The parties intend to periodically review the activities undertaken and the progress made and to consult concerning potential amendments, renewal or termination of this MOU. However, despite this clause, either party may terminate this MOU at any time by providing written notice of such termination to the other party.

#### General Terms

This MOU is not intended to, and does not create any right, benefit or trust responsibility, substantive or procedural, enforceable at law or equity, by either party, its officers, employees, or agents against the other party, its officers, employees, or agents.

Nothing in this MOU obligates either party to commit or transfer any funds, assets, or other resources in support projects or activities between the two parties.

Neither party will use the name of the other, either expressly or by implication, in any publicity, solicitation or advertisement in connection with this MoU or the activities contemplated by it, without the express written approval of the other party to this MOU.

#### Intellectual Property Rights Unaffected

The parties acknowledge that nothing in this MoU affects the intellectual property rights in any materials created or developed by a party to it, whether created or developed prior to or after the commencement of this MoU.
