

National Institute of Electronics and Information Technology Aurangabad, (hereinafter referred to as the "NIELIT Aurangabad") located at Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University Campus, Aurangabad, Maharashtra which is one of the prominent Centers of National Institute of Electronics and Information Technology (NIELIT), an Autonomous Scientific Society under the administrative control of Ministry of Electronics & Information Technology (MeitY), Government of India, New Delhi, having its registered Head Office at NIELIT Bhawan, Plot No.3, PSP Pocket, Sector-8, Dwarka-110032, New Delhi, Ethe SECOND PARTY 110077, New Delhi, of the SECOND PARTY

WHEREAS, NIELIT Aurangabad (erstwhile CEDTI), is engaged in skilling, product designing & development, applied research and consultancy in the field of Information, Electronics, Communication Technology (IECT). NIELIT Aurangabad is also a Research Centre of the Dr. B.A.M. University, Aurangabad for conducting research leading to the award of Ph.D. Degree in Engineering and Technology. It is offering capacity building courses especially in Electronics Design and Technology, Electronics product design and Development, Manufacturing (Electronics & Mechanical) Technology, Applied research and consultancy in both formal and non-formal sectors.

WHEREAS, NIELIT Aurangabad offers courses in the formal and non-formal sectors in emerging areas of IECT (Information, Electronics and Communications Technology), to make students/candidates industry ready.

WHEREAS, the Department of Computer science and Information Technology of Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University Aurangabad has proposed to enrol its students to the skill development (NSQF aligned) courses included in the Annexure - I at NIELIT Aurangabad Campus.

WHEREAS both parties have held discussions and are pleased to enter into this Memorandum of Understanding for enrolment and training of the candidates given by the first party and the training classes (theory) and practical classes will be conducted by the second party and first party respectively at their respective locations/labs/class rooms. Both the parties strongly believe that such a collaboration would lead to a continuing period of meaningful interaction, cooperation and exchange of information and ideas for mutual benefits and benefits of the students of first party. The second party may also offer a customized training program designed in consultation with the first party and funded by the first party other than courses included in Annexure I.

Both parties shall endeavour to work towards fulfilling their roles and responsibilities.

1. Roles & responsibilities of NIELIT Aurangabad

1.1. NIELIT Aurangabad to conduct theory classes of the said courses through its State-ofthe-art 'Smart' Classrooms with high-speed data networks and large projection systems may be used for imparting training.

By signing this MOU, the "Parties" acknowledge that it correctly the understanding they have reached with regard to this MOU. 12. Arbitration & Jurisdiction
