



- High performance liquid chromatography (HPLC) is basically a highly improved form of column liquid chromatography.
- Chromatographic separations can be carried out using a variety of stationary phases.



Gas Chromatography (GC)

- Sample injector port**: A sample port is necessary for introducing the sample at the head of the column.
- Column oven**: The thermostatted oven serves to control the temperature of the column within a few tenths of a degree to conduct precise work.
- Column**: Types of column, *packed* and *capillary*. Most commonly used *capillary column* is 6% cyanopropylphenyl-94% dimethylpolysiloxane i.e. C43 phase as per USP
- Detector**: The detector is the device located at the end of the column, which provides a quantitative measurement of the components of the mixture, as they elute in combination with the carrier gas. *Flame ionization detectors, thermal conductivity detector, Electron captured detector* are gen

- Be aware of body language.

□ Body language is a key part of communication.

□ When you're meeting people during the interview process, keep in mind the attributes you want your body language to display.

For example, if you want to communicate confidence, keep your shoulders back, chin raised and chest high. Maintaining eye contact as you introduce yourself is another good practice, showing interviewers you're engaged in the conversation and capable of communicating well with your potential future colleagues.


Pro-tip: Unsure about how you may be presenting yourself during introductions? Try recruiting a friend or family member for a practice session on introducing yourself including your dress, body language and even your handshake. The mirror is a great practice tool too.
