After the assessment, assessed answersheets are being shown to the students and grievances in the evaluation (if any) are redressed at the Departmental Levels. If students not satisfied at the Departmental Level, he may write to Director, Board of Examination & Evaluation about is grievance. During the year 2022-23, no grievances are received at the office of Director, Board of Examination & Evaluation. **Process Overview:**

Under this framework, departments maintain the authority to set their question papers, evaluate responses, and organize examinations. The Departmental Examination Committee oversees these processes. Following assessment, students have the opportunity to review their evaluated answer sheets, and any grievances regarding evaluation discrepancies are addressed within the department.

**Escalation Procedure:**

In cases where students remain dissatisfied with resolution at the departmental level, they are entitled to escalate their grievances to the Director of the Board of Examination & Evaluation. However, it is noteworthy that during the academic year 2022-23, no grievances were received at the office of the Director, Board of Examination & Evaluation.
