Brief Report

On August 10, 2019, the Vasantrao Naik Study Centre of Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University organized a Health Check-up and Blood Donation Camp in Aurangabad. The event aimed to provide essential health services, raise awareness about regular health check-ups, and encourage blood donation as a vital community service. The event was organized by the Vasantrao Naik Study Centre, Dr. BAMU, with University Health Centre, medical professionals, and community health workers as partners. Key activities included an inauguration ceremony, where the Director of the Vasantrao Naik Study Centre delivered a welcome address emphasizing the importance of health and community service. Notable guests, including local government representatives and healthcare professionals, shared their perspectives on the significance of health check-ups and blood donation.

The health check-up camp provided free medical consultations by Doctor from University and doctors from local hospitals, including general health assessments, blood pressure monitoring, diabetes screening, and eye examinations. Specialized services were also offered, such as dental check-ups, nutrition counselling, and mental health support. A dedicated blood donation drive was organized in collaboration with local blood banks and hospitals, with trained medical staff supervised the collection process to ensure safety and efficiency. Donor awareness sessions were held to educate participants about the importance of blood donation, the donation process, and the impact of their contributions on saving lives. Donation certificates were awarded to blood donors, recognizing their contribution to the community and encouraging future participation. Health education talks were conducted by medical professionals on topics such as preventive healthcare, nutrition, hygiene, and managing chronic diseases. Interactive workshops focused on first aid, healthy living practices, and disease prevention provided practical knowledge and skills. Community discussions were held with community members to understand their health needs and challenges, fostering a collaborative approach to addressing local health issues. There were 48 blood donors and 217 medical checkups. The event's outcomes and impact included improved health access, increased blood donation, enhanced donor awareness, and strengthened community ties. Challenges faced included reaching underserved populations, ensuring quality of services, and ensuring accessibility within the communities. Feedback and testimonials from participants expressed gratitude for the free healthcare services and the opportunity to contribute to the community through blood donation. Some suggestions for improvement include organizing regular health camps, expanding healthcare services, enhancing community outreach efforts, and strengthening partnerships with local healthcare providers, NGOs, and government agencies. In conclusion, the Health Check-up and Blood Donation Camp organized by the Vasant Rao Naik Study Centre of Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University was a significant success, providing essential healthcare services and raising awareness about
