Brief Report

On February 1, 2020, Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University (BAMU) organized a one-day workshop on the Unnat Bharat Abhiyan (UBA) initiative to educate and engage students, faculty, and local community representatives in contributing to the national mission of sustainable rural development. 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Pre-event preparations included planning and coordination by a committee comprising NSS coordinators, faculty members, and student volunteers, resource allocation, communication and outreach, community engagement through meetings with local community leaders, volunteer recruitment, and preparation of educational materials. Event activities and implementation included an inauguration ceremony, where the Vice-Chancellor of Dr. BAMU inaugurated the workshop, delivered a keynote speech, and provided an overview presentation on Unnat Bharat Abhiyan. Participants discussed rural challenges such as poverty, lack of infrastructure, and inadequate access to education and healthcare. Case studies and success stories were presented, showcasing innovative solutions for rural development. Interactive workshops involved group discussions on potential solutions to rural challenges, action plan development, and community engagement activities.
