Bridge Course for First Year Students

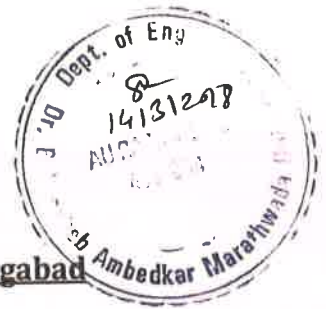

The Department of English at Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University, Aurangabad, has been offering a Bridge Course for first-year students to facilitate a smooth transition from high school to university-level studies. The course aims to enhance language proficiency, prepare students for academic challenges, facilitate a smooth transition, and boost confidence in using English in both academic and social contexts. The Bridge Course is designed as an intensive program, typically lasting two to four weeks, providing a blend of theoretical knowledge and practical application. It covers various aspects of language skills development, including reading comprehension, writing proficiency, speaking skills, listening skills, academic skills training, soft skills and personal development, and technology integration. The course is conducted at the start of the academic year, usually in July or August, with classes held five days a week, lasting approximately three hours. Faculty members from the Department of English, along with guest lecturers from other departments, deliver the course using various teaching methods, including lectures, group discussions, workshops, and hands-on activities. Continuous assessment is conducted through quizzes, assignments, and class participation to gauge students' progress, and regular feedback is provided to help identify areas for improvement and track their development. The department also offers counseling services to help students adjust to university life and manage any academic or personal challenges.


Minutes of the Departmental Committee Meeting held on September 02, 2022
