

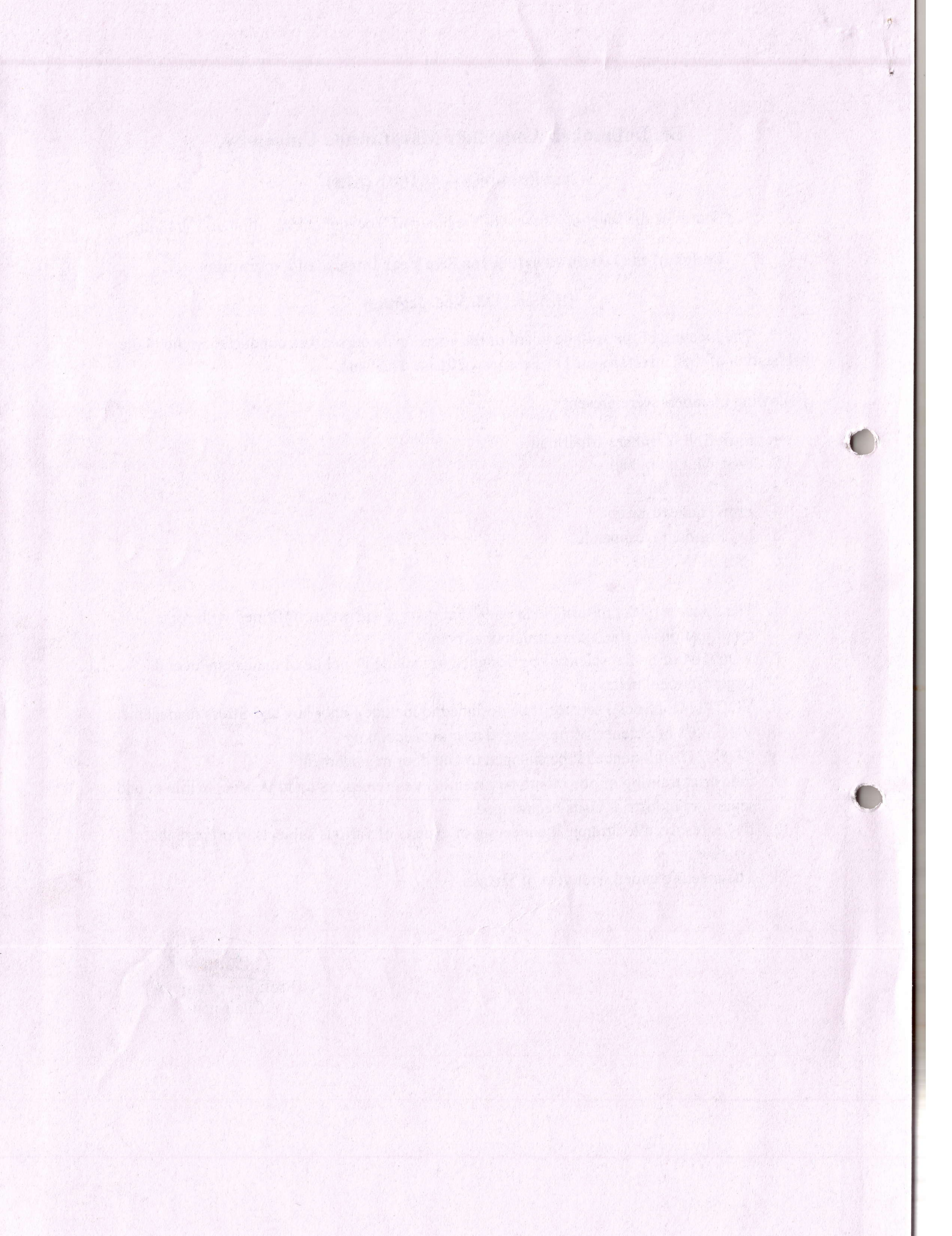
The meeting of the Ad-hoc board of the vocational courses was conducted in the Phule sabhagriah of the University on 27th February, 2013 at 11.30 am.

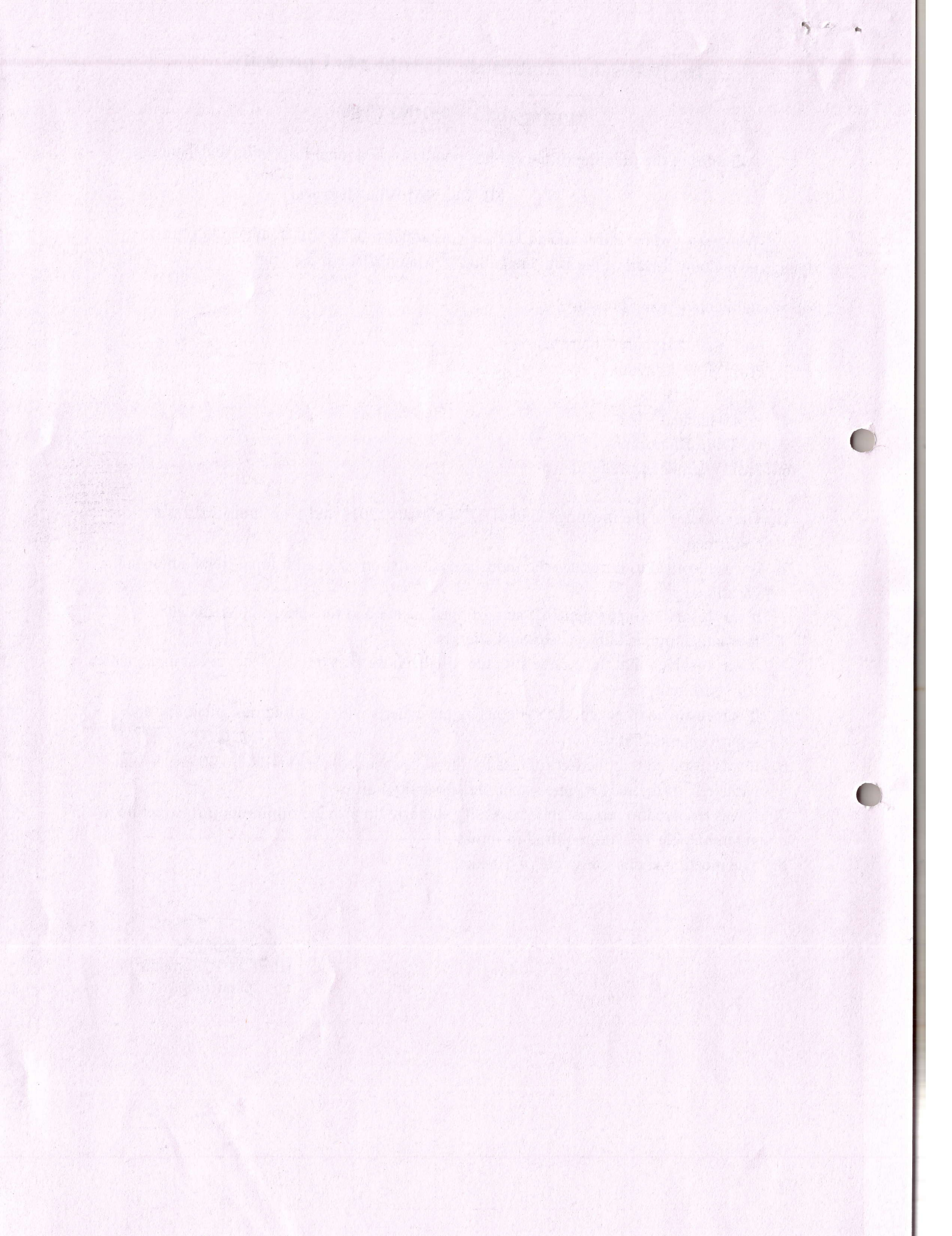
The meeting of the Ad-hoc board of the vocational courses was conducted in the Management Council Hall of the University on 21st March, 2013 at 3.30 pm.

8. The meeting ended with vote of Thanks.

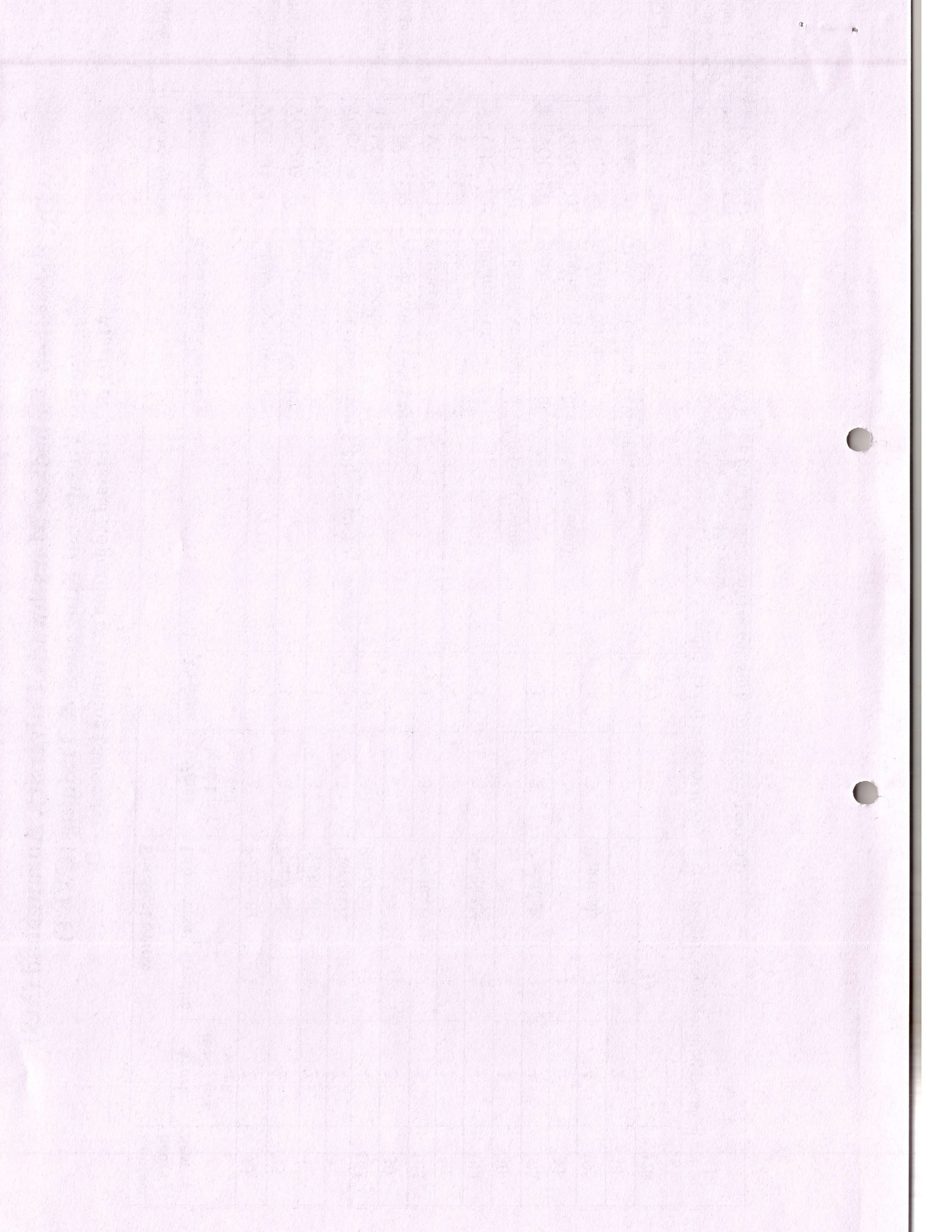

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
Minutes of the Ad-hoc Board of Studies of Centre for Vocational Education and Training (CVET)

2. The minor modification in course structure for Five Year Master Programme in Vocational Science (B. Voc. + M. Voc.) and syllabus/ curriculum for first semester (to be implemented from academic year 2013-14) was discussed, finalized and approved.
3. Professor Dr. Mahendra D. Shirsat, Director, CVET has appraised all the members about the status of renovation work being carried at the proposed site for the CVET. The members have been informed that the regular classes are going to be commenced from August 1, 2013.
4. For expediting the renovation work of the Centre, keeping in view - (i) forthcoming NAAC visit; and (ii) commencement of classes from August 1, 2013; it was decided to convey the concerns of all members of ad-hoc board studies (about the renovation work) to the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor.

Meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Hon'ble Chair and members of the committee.
