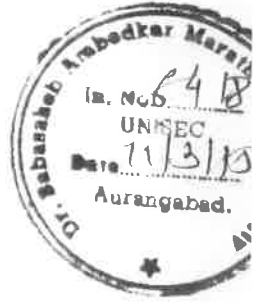

Dear Sir/Madam,

I am happy to convey that KHEDKAR VINOD BABASAHEB has been awarded a Centrally Administered Doctoral Fellowship by the ICSSR for Two years. The sanction letter is being issued initially for **ONE YEAR** with effect from **17/1/2015 to 16/1/2016** to work on the above topic. The Fellowship is subject to the following terms and conditions:

Fellowship @ Rs.16,000/-p.m. for 12 months	:Rs. 1,92,000/-
Contingency Grant @ Rs.15,000/-p.a.	:Rs.15,000/-
Total	:Rs.2,07,000/-

1. The sanction grants of Rs 2,07,000/- will be released as follows:

- First Installment - 1,00,000/-
- Second Installment - 92,000/-
- Third Installment- 15,000/-

a) The first installment of Rs. 1,00,000/ will be released on receipt of enclosed 'Grant-in-aid Bill' duly completed, signed and Stamped by the Registrar/Principal/Director of the University/College/Institute, across a revenue stamp of usual denomination.

b) The second installment of Rs.92,000/- will be released only after completion of six months and on receipt of detailed six-monthly progress report indicating clearly the work already done and the work left to be done through the supervisor and simple **statement of expenditure** incurred against the released first installment of grant and **Grant in aid bill**.

2) The renewal of the fellowship for the subsequent year will be subject to the annual progress report and statement of accounts for the entire grant released, to be found satisfactory. The renewal has to be sought before the expiry of the first year fellowship. Retrospective extension will not be sanctioned. Upon Extension, the **third installment** of Rs.15,000/- and First Installment of Rs 1,00,000/- for the Second Year will be released on receipt of Grant in aid bill for both the installments.

In between the period of first year's fellowship, if a scholar has left the fellowship to take up a job without prior permission of ICSSR he/she will have to refund the entire amount to the affiliating institution. The affiliating institution will return the amount through cheque/draft in favor of 'ICSSR' immediately.

3. The drawl of the monthly fellowship and the contingency grant will be governed by the rules of the affiliating Institute/University.

4. The Fellow shall do whole time research work under an approved guide on the topic for which the fellowship was given by the Council. Any modification/change in the topic of research will need Council's prior approval.

5. The Fellow shall not accept or hold any appointment (paid or otherwise) or receive any emoluments, salary, stipend etc., from any other source during the tenure of the award. However, a doctoral fellow may undertake teaching

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assignments for not more than four hours a week, assisting in tutorials, evaluation of the papers, laboratory/demonstration work, etc., which would help him/her in future as a teacher.

6. The tenure of a regular doctoral fellowship is strictly for **two years** only and will not be extended under any circumstances.

7. Every doctoral fellow shall submit a copy of his/her approved thesis to the Council.

8. The fellow shall not join without prior permission of ICSSR any other course of study or appear at any other examination conducted by any University or Public body. Contravention of this rule will lead to automatic termination of fellowship.

9. If it appears to the ICSSR at any point of time that the progress or conduct of the fellow has not been satisfactory, his/her fellowship may be suspended or terminated forthwith.

10. Leave for a maximum period of thirty days in a year in addition to general holidays observed by the officiating institutes/university may be taken by a fellow with the approval of the supervisor. This leave, if not utilized within a year, cannot be carried over to the subsequent year. The general holidays, however, do not include the vacation period, e.g. Summer, winter, and pooja vacations. Any leave in excess of the annual limit of 30 days, taken for whatever reasons, will be without the fellowship. Alternatively, the period of fellowship may be extended by a period equal to the duration of such leave depending on the merits of each case.

11. Institutional fellows must stay and work full time at the affiliating institute. However, they may go on field work with the express approval of their supervisors. For rest of the period they must stay and work at the concerned Institute.

12. The University/ institution to which the grant is sanctioned and released shall submit to the Council an Audited Statement of Accounts and Utilization Certificate in GFR 19A form duly signed by the statutory auditors annually.

- (i) In case the statutory auditors of the Organization do not inspect the accounts each year, a simple statement of accounts and utilization certificate duly signed either by the Finance Officer or Head of the Organization, quoting page numbers of the annual accounts in which the receipt of grant and expenditure were recorded, has to be sent to the ICSSR.
- (ii) If, later during the course of statutory audit any discrepancy regarding the utilization of the grant is disclosed it would immediately be brought to the notice of the ICSSR.

13. The Institute/University to which the grant is released shall maintain subsidiary accounts of the Government grants and should keep the books open for Audit by the CAG of India and ICSSR.

14. The amount of grant sanctioned herein is to be utilized by stipulated period. Any amount of the grant remaining unspent during this period shall be refunded to the ICSSR immediately after completion of the Programme along with the simple statement of expenditure. If the Grantee fails to utilize the grant, it will be refunded to the ICSSR with **interest thereon @10% p.a.** from the date of its sanction.
