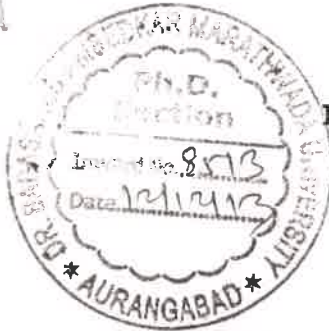


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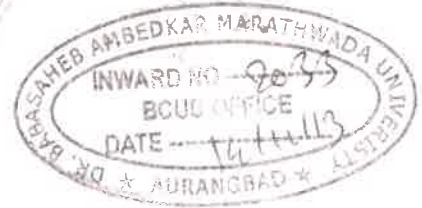

SANCTION ORDER

SUBJECT: Award of Post Doctoral Fellowship to **Dr. D.M. Bhosle** for two years to work on **"Impact of ICT on Indian Society: A study of Rural Areas in Maharashtra."**

Dear Sir,

I am directed to convey that **Dr. D.M. Bhosle** has been awarded Post Doctoral Fellowship by the ICSSR for two years. The sanction order is being issued initially for a period of one year w.e.f. **01.10.2013 to 30.09.2014.**

The fellowship is subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. The amount of fellowship and contingency grant will be as under:
For one year

- i. Fellowship amount @ Rs.28,000/- p.m. X 12 = Rs.3,36,000/-
 - ii. Contingency grant @ Rs.20,000/- p.a. = Rs. 20,000/-
- Total: = Rs:3,56,000/-**

2. The grant will be released as follows:

- i. First installment Rs.1,78,000/-
- ii Second installment Rs.1,42,400/-
- iii Third installment Rs. 35,600/-

Rs:3,56,000/-

3. The first installment of Rs.1,78,000/- will be released on receipt of the enclosed grant-in-aid bill duly signed on a revenue stamp.

4. The second installment of Rs.1,42,400/- will be released on receipt of the detailed six monthly progress report duly forwarded by Supervisor and a statement of expenditure in respect of the first six months of the fellowship.

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5. The third installment of Rs.35,600/- will be released on receipt of the comprehensive report of the work done during the tenure of the fellowship duly forwarded by the Supervisor and a statement of total expenditure incurred duly signed by the authorities of the University/ Institution.
6. Extension into the second year will be communicated on receipt of the satisfactory progress report of the work which may be submitted about a month before the expiry of the first year of the fellowship.
7. The university/institution shall provide to the fellow office accommodation including furniture library and research facilities and messengerial services. For this, the ICSSR shall pay to the University/institution overhead charges at **7.5%** of the total expenditure incurred on the fellowship after the expiry of the fellowship.
8. The University/institution will have to sent us an audited statement of expenditure and the utilization certificate **in GFR-19A form separately** duly signed by the chartered accounts for the entire expenditure incurred. The overheads will be released only after the audited accounts and the utilization certificate are received and accepted by the ICSSR after the expiry of the fellowship.
9. The contingency grant may be utilized for stenographic assistance, books, stationery, computer cost, research assistance and the field work expenses connected with the research work.
10. During the tenure of the fellowship the fellow will be treated as an employee of the University/institution for all the administrative purposes and the rules of the university/ institution shall apply in the matter of drawls of TA/DA holidays and contingency grant.
11. The fellow shall work on a whole-time basis and shall not receive any financial assistance from any other source during the tenure of the fellowship.
12. The fellow shall not accept any assignment (with or without payment) without the prior permission of the ICSSR.
13. Fellowships are income tax free for retired and unemployed scholars. Pay protection fellowships are under income tax act as per government of Indian rule.
14. Unless the ICSSR decides otherwise, all equipment's if purchased out of the contingency grant, should be transferred to the affiliating institution, which shall certify that it has been noted in its stock register. However, books purchased out of contingency grant may be retained by the scholar.
15. The fellows shall submit three copies of the final report on the work done by him/her as fellow of the Council, in a publishable form along with an abstract of the report within about 5000 words within a period of six months of the expiry of the fellowship.

16. In case the report is not received within the stipulated period/extended period the fellow will be debarred from any financial support under any scheme of the council including support for visits abroad whether as individual scholar or as member of the delegation. He/She will also not be associated with any committee/programmes the Council may set up/organise from time to time.

17. The amount of grant sanctioned herein is to be utilized by stipulated period. Any amount of the grant remaining unspent during this period shall be refunded to the ICSSR immediately after completion of the project. If the grantee fails to utilize the grant for the purpose for which the same has been sanctioned, the grantee will be required to refund the amount of the grant with interest thereon @10% per annum from date of its sanction.

18. Other terms and conditions will remain unchanged.

19. The Council has approved the Supervisor **Prof. V.L. Dharurkar** for the Post-Doctoral Fellowship awarded to **Dr. D.M. Bhosle**.

Dear Dr. Gore,

This is in response to your application for the award of Post -Doctoral Fellowship for the year 2013-14 to work on the topic, "**Changing Dimensions of Development Journalism in Maharashtra**".

The expert Committee has evaluated your research fellowship proposal.

I am directed to convey that the above proposal has been approved by the competent authorities of the Council for the award of Post -Doctoral Fellowship for a **period of two years**.

You would be expected to work under the guidance of a working senior social scientist who will certify the progress of the work at every stage.

During the fellowship period, you will be paid a consolidated fellowship amount of **Rs.28,000/-** per month. Besides, a contingency grant of **Rs.20,000/-** per annum will be given to cover the expenses on research assistance, travel, data collection, computer work, stationery, books, etc. You are required to work full time on this fellowship and must not accept any other assignment with or without payment. **(Fellowship and contingency grant are tax free).**

You will have to affiliate yourself to a recognized academic institution/university/college for the purpose of disbursement of your fellowship amount. The affiliating body will be required to provide research infrastructure to you for the completion of your research work on the topic. **The Council will be paying 7½% overhead charges to the affiliating body for this purpose.**

Kindly send us the following documents to enable us to issue a formal letter of sanction.

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1. A letter of consent from the affiliating institution to the effect that it is willing to affiliate you as a Post-Doctoral fellow (Forwarding letter format enclosed) duly signed by Competent Authority.
2. Date of joining report though the affiliating institution to the effect that you join the fellowship (format enclosed) duly signed by you, Supervisor and Competent Authority
3. A copy of agreement with the ICSSR (format enclosed) duly signed by you.

I am enclosing the Grant-in-aid bill for the 1st Instalment of the 1st year of Rs.1,78,000/-. Kindly send it back to us after it is signed by the Head of the affiliating Institute (Registrar in the case of University, Director in the case of Institutes and the Principal of the College).

The above mentioned documents, duly completed, should reach the ICSSR with **within 10 days from the issue date if this award letter**, so that a formal letter of sanction can be issued to you.
