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Detailed Report

Workshop on Intellectual Property Rights was organized by Rashtriya Uchcharat Shiksha Abhiyan, Maharashtra (RUSA) with the collaboration of Rajiv Gandhi National Institute of Intellectual Property Management (RGNIIPN), Nagpur and Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University, Aurangabad on 22nd August 2016 at 9:30 AM to 6:00 PM at CFART auditorium. Total 212 participants were present for the workshop. During registration a proper kit was provided containing a pen, notepad, study material, I-card and lunch coupon. The guest of the day was welcomed by giving a book of Dr. A.P.J. Abdul Kalam as a token of gratitude. During the inaugural speech, Honorable Vice Chancellor Prof. Dr. B. A. Chopde explained about the importance of Intellectual Property Rights and Patents in research and also encouraged students and scholars to come forward with the same. The program was scheduled, including two sessions. The first session included two lectures which were delivered by Mr. Prashant Thakur on the topics Introduction to IPR, Organization and Its Website, Invention as per Patent Act and Patentability Criteria. He explained about three main criteria required for application of patent that are novelty, inventive steps and industrial applicability of patents. He also explained about inventions that are not patentable in India, types of patents (process patent & product patent) and advantages of patent. After the lunch (break of 1 hour), the second session was conducted by Mr. Suhas Kulkarni on Indian patent application filing procedure and types, documents required for filing application in India, priority date of application, publication of the application, unity of invention, amendments withdrawal, postdating, term of the patent and renewal. He also delivered knowledge about patent application filling procedure, who can apply for patents, documents

required for filling patent in India. During the discussion session the speakers answered the doubts and queries of the audience satisfactorily. Certificates were distributed at the end of the workshop. The information that was provided by the speakers in their areas of interest was very much fruitful to the audience.
