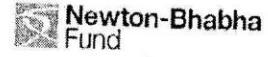

b) British Council/ UK

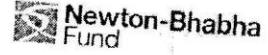
- Monthly stipend of £1,300 per month to cover meals, accommodation and domestic travel, etc and Bench Fee (as per Actual).

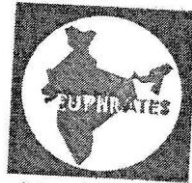

## SCHOLARSHIP AWARD LETTER

To whom it may concern,

The Consortium of the project *EU Promotion of Health through Research, Applied Technology, Education and Science in India – EUPHRATES*, coordinated by the Universidade de Santiago de Compostela, has awarded **KESHAV DATTATRAYA SHINDE** a scholarship in the 2<sup>nd</sup> cohort of EUPHRATES Programme, under the Erasmus Mundus Action 2, Strand 1 regulations.
