



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN

'BEIJING INSTITUTE OF GRAPHIC COMMUNICATION, BEIJING, CHINA'

'DR. BABASAHEB AMBEDKAR MARATHWADA UNIVERSITY, AURANGABAD, INDIA'

1. THE AGREEMENT

1.1. Beijing Institute of Graphic Communication, Beijing, China (hereinafter called the BIGC, Beijing) which expression shall, where the context so admits, include its students & faculty members of the other part.

And

- 1.2. THE AGREEMENT made and entered into on this 12th Day of May, 2016 (12th Day of Two Thousand and Sixteen) between Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University, Aurangabad (hereinafter called the BAMU, Aurangabad) which expression shall, where the context so admits, include its successors and permitted assignees of the one part. Department of Printing Technology & Graphic Arts shall be beneficiary on behalf of Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University, Aurangabad.
- 1.3. The MoU between above two parties is being signed under the aegis of All India Federation of Master Printers (AIFMP, Delhi).

2. PREAMBLE

- 2.1. WHEREAS BIGC, Beijing, CHINA has developed as a unique facility for research in the areas of Printing Technology and has eminent faculty,
- 2.2. WHEREAS BAMU, Aurangabad, INDIA has developed as a unique facility for research in the areas of Printing, Graphics & Packaging Technology and has eminent faculty,
- 2.3. AND WHEREAS BIGC, Beijing and BAMU, Aurangabad, INDIA agrees to extend mutual co-operation on terms and conditions hereinafter contained.

3. SCOPE OF AGREEMENT

- 3.1. This agreement details the modalities and the term and conditions for academic cooperation and Teachers and Students Exchange between BIGC, Beijing and BAMU, Aurangabad the rights and obligations of either PARTY thereto and other arrangements between the parties.
- 3.2. The MOU shall come into force from date of signing of this agreement (hereinafter called the EFFECTIVE DATE) and shall remain valid for 5 years or until superseded or cancelled.

4. RESPONSIBILITIES OF BAMU, AURANGABAD AND BIGC, BEIJING

4.1. BAMU, Aurangabad shall recognize BIGC, Beijing as an academic and research center at par with the BAMU, Aurangabad and faculty of BIGC, Beijing at par with faculty of BAMU, Aurangabad for academic, research and Teachers-Students Exchange program.

- 4.2. Both the collaborating Universities will provide opportunity to teachers and students to conduct research and training in their laboratories.
- 4.3. The necessary Contingencies/consumables, if required, shall be provided by collaborating universities subject to availability without affecting the normal working of the respective departments of the Universities. The costs and expenditure or project contingencies will be shared by mutual consent.
- 4.4. The student shall submit a copy of his/her proposal/report to the BAMU &/or BIGC.
- 4.5. BIGC, Beijing, CHINA/BAMU, Aurangabad, INDIA shall allow its infrastructure and facilities to be used by the students selected for training in BAMU &/or BIGC, Beijing under Students exchange program.

5. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

5.1. Intellectual property, research publications and benefits arising out of commercialization of technology generated out of co-operation under this agreement shall be jointly owned by BIGC, Beijing, CHINA and BAMU, Aurangabad, CHINA or on mutually agreeable terms.

6. TERMINATION OF AGREEMENT

6.1. The MOU shall be effective from the date of its signing by both the parties and shall remain in operation until either Party serves notice to the other for its intention to terminate it. In such events, the MOU shall stand terminated at the end of one calendar month from the date of issue of such notice. In case both the parties agree to terminate the MOU, the on-going training work will be completed.

7. AMENDMENTS TO THE AGREEMENT

7.1. The Parties to this MOU may, by mutual consent, add, modify, amend or delete any word, phrase, sentence or article in this MOU at any time during the operation of MOU.
