



COOPERATION AGREEMENT

BETWEEN The Polytechnic Institute of Leiria AND The Dr Babasaheb

Ambedkar Marathwada University, Department of Tourism Administration

Between:

The Polytechnic Institute of Leiria, hereinafter referred to as IPL, having its main address at Rua General Norton de Matos, 2401-901 Leiria (PORTUGAL), here represented by its President, Nuno André de Oliveira Mangas Pereira,

And

The Dr Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University, Department of Tourism Administration, hereinafter referred to as BAMU-DTA VAT number _____, with headquarters at Aurangabad (MS), India here represented by the Registrar Mr.D. B. Bharad

In consideration of the common interest of developing the cooperation between the parties and the mutual covenants and conditions contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

Article 1

This agreement intends to establish the bases of cooperation on matters of mutual interest, particularly in technical, scientific and educational areas between the IPL and BAMU-DTA

Article 2

The cooperation between the two parties will take the terms that are most appropriate for the development of partnerships in the areas covered by this agreement, particularly for the implementation of the following actions:





- a) The exchange of technical, scientific and educational literature;
- b) Students' and professors' mobility;
- c) The organization of events (conferences, seminars, etc.,);
- d) The organization of degree and non-degree courses and lectures;
- e) The development of research projects;
- f) The activities of technical and administrative personnel;
- g) Services;
- h) Other activities that can be considered under this agreement;

Article 3

Given the diversity of possibilities of cooperation between the parties involved in this agreement, it can be subject to eventual additions to be signed by both parties.

Article 4

Whenever payments are required, these will be done through the institutions in accordance with the legal standards applicable.

Article 5

Both parties considerer the characteristics of each one, such as its statutes and internal regulations, its organization, labor periods, budget, institutional ties and respect for its laws, to be safeguarded.







Article 6

- 1. This agreement becomes effective as of the date it is signed and is valid unless terminated by either party by giving the other party at least 180 days' written notice. In any case, this Agreement can be revised at any time, if mutually agreed.
- 2. Both parties undertake to comply with the ongoing activities until this agreement terminates.
