Memorandum of Understanding

between

Manashakti REST New Way, Lonavala and

Department of Computer Science and Information Technology, of the Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar
Marathwada University, Aurangabad

For the period starting from January 2018

Manashakti REST New Way (herein referred to as Manashakti) and Department of Computer Science and Information Technology, of the Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University (herein referred to as DCSIT) hereby enter into the following agreement with a vision to promote cooperation and collaboration in the fields of mutual interest related to research, learning, technology and education. This memorandum is not intended to create binding or legal obligations on either party.

Manashakti and DCSIT will jointly organize workshops and courses for students, teachers and academicians. In these, Manashakti will provide guidance to DCSIT's students, teachers on the following topics: Stress Free Success, Mind & Brain Development, Personality Development and so on.

Article 1:

Joint activities will be undertaken by agreement of both parties. This collaboration is undertaken to enhance the exchange of emotional awareness, ethical values, moral values, leadership development, personality development and team building with a view to make an impact globally.

Article 2:

Both organizations will come together to formulate innovative projects combining various Manashakti's research concepts and DCSIT's technological expertise. Projects will be formulated with a view of implementation in real-life scenarios.

Article 3:

Both organizations will co-operate and collaborate with each other to publish research papers in various national and international journals of repute, on research concepts that are mutually agreed upon. Both parties can jointly organise conferences or symposia on subjects of mutual interest.

Article 4:

By way of this agreement, DCSIT students will gain practical learning by participating in the following activities at Manashakti :

1. Under Manashakti's guidance, DCSIT will provide assistance for development of softwares, applications, databases regarding various social welfare concepts.
2. DCSIT's students would be able to study for a Ph.D. degree on various topics of Manashakti with mutual consent.
3. Development of various mobile Apps from time to time.
4. Projects will be planned across various technologies, such as, New & Emerging technologies, Computer-Brain Interface, Bio-Signals Capture & Analysis and so on.
5. Because of a continuous stream of footfall for Manashakti's activities, a lot of data can be collected. Data Storage and Analysis is a key area which can be looked upon for research and development of live projects.

Article 6: Financials

Both parties understand that all financial arrangements will have to be negotiated separately & it is subject to be change as per the discussion of Institution Management.

Article 7: Intellectual Property

All intellectual property rights, including patents, trademarks, copyrights and so on, arising out of projects or any other joint activities will reside with the party who has initiated the concept. For the concepts which have jointly initiated, the IP will reside jointly.

Article 8: Non Disclosure

DCSIT and all of its students will adhere to non-disclosure of information, processes, product designs and any other sensitive data and information with any other third party which is not working on specific projects.

Article 9: Review & Renewal

Both parties shall review the status of the agreement at the end of every three year period to determine any modification that shall be necessary. The period of validity of this agreement shall be extended by mutual consent.

Article 10: Termination

Either party may terminate this agreement with written notification signed by designated officials of the party initiating termination. Such notification must be given at least 6 months in advance of the effective date of termination.
