

Memorandum of Understanding (MOU)

THIS Memorandum of Understanding is made on 10th day of September Month 2018 between:

Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University (Dr. BAMU), University Campus, Jaisingpura, Near Soneri Mehel, Aurangabad – 431004.

AND

Garware Community Centre's Garware Bal Bhavan, N-7, B-1, CIDCO, Near CIDCO Police Station, Aurangabad -431003.

About Dr. BAMU

The Marathwada University was established on 23rd August 1958. It was renamed in 1994 as Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University. The University campus is spread over an area of 720 acres embraced by lush green mountain ranges, interspersed with gardens and ancient and ancient historical monuments, balancing traditional and modern changes. The University has a strength of 4730 on the campus and 1,25,000 students from 404 affiliated colleges converging from all over India as well as world that focus primarily on high teaching standards research both for the faculty and students. The University ceaselessly adopts new methods of improving courses and programmes.

The University campus is located at Aurangabad around 350 km from Mumbai, the capital city of Maharashtra state, the campus offers top quality facilities and services for teaching, learning, research as well as extra-curricular activities like cultural and physical activities. The sub campus at Osmanabad is around 250 km from Aurangabad and is closer to rural students caters to their needs for higher education in professional studies. The center for coastal and marine biodiversity caters to their needs for higher education in professional subjects. The centre for Coastal and Marine biodiversity, a satellite campus at Ratnagiri is engaged in marine research. The Centre also disseminates Potential Fishing Zone (PFZ) information to the local fishermen through digital display board in collaboration with INCOIS (Hyderabad) besides offering training to local people in SCUBA diving and snorkeling.

The University has picked up six distinctive core commitments that mould our singular status in higher education in the region. These core values are the guiding spirit behind all our activities.

1. To make higher education accessible to rural youth

Garware Polyester Limited has set-up a Community Centre at N-7, CIDCO, Aurangabad in the year 1993. The basic object of starting the activities of Community Centre is to develop Social, Cultural, Educational and Sports awareness among the common people of all age groups.

While working with the Society it has been noticed necessary for the school going children of the working class to have a common place for their study, social, educational, cultural and physical development. With this view in mind the Community Centre has started various socio-culture activities as has been narrated in the foregoing paragraphs. All the activities are conducting on regular basis. Garware Community Centre has been organizing Theatre & Film Acting Workshop for children in the age group of 13 years to 18 years. The object is personality development through theatre activity. Along with theatre and cinema the planning emphasizes on increasing awareness about various fields of knowledge like journalism, banking, health, social services, politics etc. So far, approximately 300 boys and girls have undergone the training. Eminent cine personalities like Hon. Rajdatta, Chandrakant Kulkarni were kind enough in imparting necessary training to these students.

Moreover, Garware has started a Community Centre in rural area at Waluj Village, Tq- Gangapur which is working on drinking water project, Farmers' awareness programme etc.

The Garware Community Centre has truly emerged as a people's organization. In 1999 GCC has registered under 'Bombay Public Trust Act 1950' as a Charitable Public Trust.

We have affiliated to National Bal Bhavan, New Delhi. (An autonomous Institution set up by Govt. of India) and also the Registered Centre of Directorate of Cultural Affairs, Govt. of Maharashtra.

This Memorandum of Undertaking (MOU) affirms that Garware Community Centre's Garware Bal Bhavan, Aurangabad and Department of Dramatics, Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University, Aurangabad shall work together to develop **youth artists** in Aurangabad. More specifically, the parties to this MOU shall cooperate and work together for the "Mutual benefits" in respect of the following activities, and in the manner specified:

On a 'Voluntary Basis'

4. Both the organizations can participate in various programs organized by the both the organizations – in line with vision.
5. Interested members your organization can volunteer to become Mentor or Trainer.
6. To provide regular support to each other to source mentors and resource persons.
7. Providing each other the meeting / workshop facilities whenever possible.
8. Helping in developing cultural activities in the field of Drama, Dance, Music and Folk Art.
9. Identifying resource persons.

Both the Institutions recognize that:

- a. This MOU establish a foundation of mutual understanding and interest and does not itself entail any financial obligations for either institutions;
- b. This MOU will take effect from the date of its signing and shall be valid for the period of Five years from the date, unless terminated earlier upon six months' notice be either institutions;
- c. This MOU may be revoked or modified by mutual agreement between the institutions and may be extended its initial Five year term by mutual agreement.

Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University, Aurangabad, Department of Dramatics and Garware Community Centre's Garware Bal Bhavan, Aurangabad wishing to establish relations between the institutions, hereby agree to cooperate with each other in areas of mutual interest as follows:

1. The purpose of this Agreement is to develop academic, educational and cultural cooperation and to promote mutual understanding between the Institutions.
2. The terms of cooperation for each specific activity implemented under this MOU shall be mutually discussed and agreed upon in writing by both parties in a separate agreement, prior to the initiation of that activity. Any such implementation agreements will form appendices to this memorandum of Understanding.
3. The development and implementation of specific activities based on this Agreement will be separately negotiated and agreed between the faculties, which carry out the specific projects. Both institutions agree to carry out these activities in accordance with the laws and regulations of the respective institutions after full consultation and approval.
4. Financial and/or funding considerations shall become the subject of specific discussions and agreement within the framework of a separate implementation agreement. No financial commitment whatsoever, on the part of either signatory to this general document, is intended or implied.
5. It is understood that the implementation of any of the type of

6. Should any collaborative research activity under this Agreement result in any potential for intellectual property, both institutions shall seek an equitable and fair understanding as to ownership and other property interests that may arise.
7. Each Institution shall designate a liaison officer to develop and coordinate the specific activities agreed upon. The designated liaison officers for this Memorandum of Understanding are:
