Earn and Learn Scheme

Samrath

- University initiated this scheme from 1979 and approximately 1,17,228 students are benefitted.
- 75% Rural Students including boys and girls are pursuing their education in the university and this provides status of rural university to Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University, Aurangabad.
- Postgraduate Students of Ist and IInd year are paid 1300/- per month and M.Phil Ph.D. students are getting 1500/- per month
- Students work at ground for two hours in the morning for maintaining cleanliness, manufacturing items like pockets, files, folders, used at all the administrative and academic sections of the university, students of M.Phil and PhD help the clerical staff of the academic departments.
- 60% Students are getting 1000-1500 rupees out of the scheme.
- 77% Students are BPL category.
- 88% of Students in this scheme are taking education in faculty of Arts.
- 70% students can't complete their education if the scheme is not in the university.

- 387 colleges are benefitted out this scheme, university pays Five Thousand rupees and college adds the same amount for five students who are working under this scheme for 6 months.
- Students get a lesson for self reliance along with a skill to initiate their own start up as an entrepreneurship in the future life.
- The university has built and separate hostel for male students of Earn and Learn with a minimum fees.
- Through this scheme students have planted 5000 trees and examination unit
- The entire campus is converted into green campus through this scheme
- Under the scheme of Water Conservation –Jalyukta Shivar have constructed two water storage tank which help us to maintain green lush university campus
- Students have planted more than 7000 commercial Horticultural project on 150 acres of barren land of university.
