Proceedings of the IQAC Advisory Committee meeting held on 7th June, 2014

The meeting of Advisory Committee of IQAC was held on Tuesday, the 7th June 2014, at 11 am in the Management Council Hall under the chairmanship of Honorable Vice-Chancellor, when all IQAC members were present.

While Dr. S.C.Zambre, BCUD welcomed the Honorable Vice-Chancellor at the meeting, Dr. V.L.Dharurkar, Coordinator of IQAC presented a brief background about IQAC functioning.

Honorable Vice-Chancellor appreciated the IQAC's endless efforts for making record success. He further advised to keep ourselves ready to face Asia rank as well as Indian ranking.

The following business was transacted at the meeting:

1. Report on proceedings of the last meeting held on 22-8-2014

The action taken report of the earlier meeting was presented by Dr. V.L.Dharurkar, Coordinator, IQAC Unit. The Honorable Vice-Chancellor advised that henceforth IQAC meeting be convened at least once in a month.

2. Suggestions by members:

The Coordinator IQAC presented before the committee the report on the status of NAAC assessment of various affiliated colleges in the jurisdiction of this University.


At the outset members pointed out that the IQAC unit is functioning on right line.

After prolonged discussions, the following suggestions were made by members:

- The Coordinator, Foreign Students Cell presented briefly 10 points of the monthly report of NAAC.

- Foreign Students Cell must be activated. On the lines of Pune University Foreign Students Cell be activated further and proposal for independent foreign students Hostel be formulated on priority basis.
- There is urgent need to approach to the Government for clearance for filling up the vacant faculty positions at various departments.
- The feedback system for students be ensured at each department by placing their Feedback suggestion box. The feedbacks received from students be scrutinized to analyze teachers' evaluation by students.
- For developing communication and soft skills among students the University Department of English should initiate requisite proposals and other relevant agencies may also be involved in the process.
- It was suggested to develop special consultancy services cell to improve the economic position of the University and it was suggested to organize workshop for this purpose.
- It was suggested to organize special training program for improving teaching-learning process for Sub Center at Osmanbad. It was suggested to examine the basic facilities available and for improving the facilities, comprehensive note be submitted at the next meeting for consideration.
- It was suggested that vocational courses be started and for this purpose a committee be appointed to examine the issue in detail.
- It was suggested to form IQAC unit in each Department and at least two meetings in one year be convened.
- It was suggested to continue efforts for quality improvement in the SWOT analysis.
- It was suggested to conduct principals' workshop in the first term and the plan of district wise workshop plan may also be prepared.
- It was suggested to that a house journal i.e. University newsletter be brought out for circulation among the University departments and affiliated colleges.
