
Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University, Aurangabad (MS) INDIA Six decades of Excellence in Education

- 2) Title: 15 words maximum, 14 pts centered with name of the author/ authors starting with surname in bracket country along with address & contact details.
- 3) Abstracts up to 300 words, 10 pts. Italics and aligned on both sides
- 4) References: Please use MLA style for references
- 5) Maximum permitted length is 2000 words
- 6) Articles should be written as continuous expository narrative- not as lists of points or Power Point presentation
- 7) Please ensure that the paper is thoroughly checked and proofread before submission
