Initiatives to address locational advantage and disadvantages

The survey was carried out in fifteen villages in Marathwada region. The main focus of the study is to analyze the socio- economic and living conditions of different tribes in the tribal area of Marathwada region i.e. Nanded, Hingoli and Aurangabad districts. This study addresses the specific objectives outlined as follow:

- 1) To study comparatively socio-economic characteristics of the scheduled tribe in Marathwada.
- 2) To study the patterns of employment, income level and to examine the level of indebtedness of the tribal households among various tribal groups in the study area.
- 3) To study the implementation of tribal development program in Marathwada region.

Conclusion:

Tribal population mainly contributes a major share of wide-spread poverty in the nation. The level of the socio-economic development varies considerably between tribal and non-tribal population, between one tribe and another tribe and even among different sub-group of tribal groups. Thus their problems differ from area to area within their own groups. These disparities and diversities make tribal development and micro level planning of tribal at the grass root level imperative.
