

Introduction

Mapping is creating graphic representations of information using spatial relationships within the data. The common and original practice of mapping is the scaled portrayal of geographical features that is cartography. In the contemporary sense of data visualization, it includes metaphorical extensions of geographical map, conventions and literacy's to another kinds of data, as well as innovative ways of visualizing data not clearly related to the geographical archetype. In popular vernacular, mapping can just mean organizing or systematizing information.

The print version has been published since 1932, Ulrich's™ is the authoritative source of bibliographic and publisher information on more than 300,000 periodicals of all types academic and scholarly journals, Open Access publications, peer-reviewed titles, popular magazines, newspapers, newsletters and more from around the world. It covers all subjects, and includes publications that are published regularly or irregularly and that are circulated free of charge or by paid subscription.
